Ideas included each class making art work for above their classroom doors, re-cyclable materials being used to make art that can be suspended overhead and a rag rug linked to our school.</li> <li>- Miss Proctor explained how the street artists work and suggested that we need a theme to develop through school. Ideas proposed were woodland and space themes. The majority felt woodland was good and it was proposed that we could incorporate our school logo and some art work surrounding the names of each class around their door. Class Councils will discuss and add to these ideas.</li> <li>- Councillors discussed the role they would like the Parent Council to have in our school. They think that they should be involved in making decisions and helping to make our school better by discussing similar items and policies to the School Council. The Head Boy and Head Girl agreed to explain how our School Council works to the Parent Council members.</li> <li>- Scarlett asked when the School Council photographs will be changed in the school entrance and Miss Proctor explained that the photographs should arrive in school shortly.</li> <li>- Millie raised an issue from lunchtimes regarding the use of the Sports Space.
