Minutes and matters arising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Councillors were very pleased that they had received a letter from Barker Court thanking them for their donations and felt that they had made a good decision. - Each class had discussed the benefits of Magic Breakfast and said the vast majority of children (all in some classes) thought it should continue. The benefits discussed were; having opportunities to socialise, improves attendance, eases congestion outside school, gives children a chance to eat if they have missed breakfast on days they are in a rush. - Each class had also thought of some suggestions to improve magic breakfast. These included; bringing back monitors to help monitor behaviour, having access to drinks, introducing a cut off time of 8:40 for magic breakfast in the hall so that people have time to eat. - Miss Proctor introduced the lunchtime agenda for Class Councils and children agreed that we need to think of ways to ensure our resources are looked after. - Year 5/6 members raised an additional item to the agenda regarding future residential trips and giving parents and children the opportunity to have a say in where the residential takes place.
