Minutes and matters arising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All councillors signed the 'code of conduct' after reading and agreeing to it. Miss Proctor explained the importance of reading something before you sign it. Councillors agreed to try and uphold the 'code of conduct' at all times. - Willow Class Council suggested that children could vote/suggest reasons for the 'Star of the Week' so that pupils have a role in recognising each other's achievements. They also suggested a 'top table' for lunchtimes on Fridays, where the stars of the week would eat at a specially laid table with milkshakes to drink! - Acorn Class Council suggested a trophy to keep/badge to wear for the week instead of having a certificate. Isabella said that Willow Class had discussed a similar idea but thought that it could be difficult if someone forgot to bring it back the following week or was absent from school. - All classes said that sometimes they feel self-conscious when doing Go Noodle at the front of the school when they had been chosen for 'Star of the Week' and asked if they could join their class to take part in Go Noodle. - We had lots of suggestions for harvest donations including: Trinity Baptist Church, The Salvation Army, Barker Court and Olive House. The Class Councils will vote where the food should be donated to. Some Councillors suggested older members of the community might enjoy a visit from children when donating the food. - As part of our discussion about playtimes children said that they are sometimes bored at playtime and would like some new equipment. There were lots of ideas for equipment including a zip wire! Miss Proctor talked about the cost of these ideas and suggested maybe we look at fundraising to raise money for any new games/equipment.
