

SPIRITUAL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We consider faiths in different cultures and the role it plays in the Spanish society. We look for similarities and differences in faiths in the UK and in Spain. Children are given the opportunities to accept and embrace other languages and cultures through the teaching of Spanish. Children are taught the religious beliefs of Spanish and the different celebrations the country have.
MORAL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We use the Spanish language to discuss responses to what is right and wrong. Children are encouraged to show empathy and understanding to others from different religions, cultures and countries.
SOCIAL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We communicate with a purpose with people from other cultures and societies. We learn the skill of communicating in a different language. Exploring different social conventions such as formal and informal greetings in Spanish. Sharing what has been learnt in Spanish. Children are encouraged to work independently and with others in all aspects of their curriculum including Spanish.
CULTURAL

Allow children to develop an appreciation of cultural differences in theatre, music, art and literature by listening to Spanish music, reading Spanish stories, and watching Spanish films. Participating in European Day of Languages. Taking part in cultural occasions such as Diwali, Chinese New Year, Eid.
