We all wear different clothes outside of school; we might have different hair and some people have a different colour of skin. We don't tell people that they cannot play a game with us. If we had someone in the class in a wheelchair we would still let them play. o Everyone gets equal help. o Everyone gets a turn in class, like in our shared writes. o Responding to every person's questions. o Same amount of dinner for every class. o Different weeks on the climbing frame. o Choose seating at lunch. o Fair PE teams. - We discussed our role in identifying bullying and decided that we all have a role to play in reporting to staff, showing confidence when addressing bullies, 'talking it out' with bullies and 'finding out the back story' from the bully themselves.
