Everyone shared the key points from their discussions which included what makes up a person's gender and their identity and what equality means. Overall everyone felt that our school treats everyone fairly, regardless of their gender. Bumble Bee's raised the point of school uniform and after a group discussion we all felt that moving forward we could just have a whole school uniform instead of a 'boys' and 'girls' uniform.</li> <li>- Acorn Class had discussed the 'girls football club' and the absence of a 'boys football club' at the moment. Willow Class councillors explained the rationale behind having a separate girls club, so that more girls had a chance to play football. Miss Proctor raised the point that many professional clubs have both a boys and girls team who participate in their own matches and competitions.</li> <li>- We all took a tour of the book corners throughout school, with the councillors from each class explaining how and when they use their book corner.
