It was suggested that we could continue the work started on recycling next year, to include recycling plastic. Miss Proctor asked for suggestions for next year's School Council. It was suggested that perhaps the councillors could have specific roles within the council e.g. eco leader, behaviour leader, charity events leader. It was also discussed that perhaps we could have two Head Pupils instead of a Head Boy and Head Girl. 3. Feedback about what we do well as a school was as follows: • Theme homework that sparks imagination and enables children and parents to dip in and out of it throughout the teaching block; • Parent events such as assemblies, craft sessions and sports day; • School dinner booking system that enables children to choose from a good selection of meals, including good vegetarian options and lets parents change meals after they have booked them; • New school newsletter format on Sway that is much easier to read on a smart device and contains lots of photos; • Children's progression in reading using the new reading scheme • Variety of sports based after school clubs (more creative/STEM clubs would be nice) and offering Bikeability for all pupils 4. Feedback about what we can improve on as a school was as follows: • Clarity on methods of communication used for parents at the start of the school year e.g. what can be found on the website / newsletters / Facebook and which platform parents should look on for key information; • Website platform could be more user friendly on a smart device, as when you click on a tab you have to scroll right down to the bottom to see it; • After school club booking procedures • Offering book recommendations of titles to read at home for each year group, possibly on each class newsletter, to help parents know what books to read with their children at home.
