Minutes and matters arising	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mrs Wood welcomed councillors and shared today's agenda. 2. Some suggestions include: bathroom lights to be permanently on, girls only football one day at lunch, hula hoops at lunch, seating in the library and non-fiction books, rota for the sports space, horse themed books, non-fiction books, more visits and trips for classes to attend. 3. Some ideas fed back from the classes include: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. a 'buddy bench' for children to sit and meet others when they might not have a friend to play with. School council wondered if we could repurpose the bench outside Acorn classroom to become the buddy bench. b. a timetable for the football area so different classes can use it on different days. c. a sheltered area/bench for reading during lunchtime play outside as well as the library area. d. games painted on the playground to play such as number squares. e. return the milk to playtime for everyone to have access to milk. f. fruit for everyone in school to access rather than just KS1. 		

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> The signs to be small signs rather than one whole sign scattered around the playground and designed by the children in our school. Charities - Bumble Bee, Acorn are to support the Princes' Trust and Willow to make a decision following their research. School Librarians, we could vote for different children to be the librarians and have a minimum of 5 librarians but no maximum so there is a rota for who is on duty on which day. School councillors have chatted about their views of Sora but feel they need to ask the children in their class for their responses to their Sora resource. School council feel the decking area would be a lovely idea to make a 'Coronation Garden'. School council have requested a little extra money to buy some additional seeds.
