- Toilet lights sometimes don't work which scares some chn. Chn scared of being hurt by the ball on the yard. The balls on the yard are too hard/bog. Lots of chn were scared/ worried about children in year one at dinner time- pulling/pushing their chairs, shouting and hitting.
- All of Acorn class felt safe in class. They have teachers who sort out their worries. Fences, locks, Dan being a referee, fire alarm checks, never being alone.
